How to get the most out of your air conditioner.



3-Speed switch controls fan speed and turns on your air conditioner.

For comfortable air flow, turn clockwise OFF-LOW-MEDIUM-HIGH.



Control air temperature with the adjustable thermostat. To lower it, turn clockwise.

LOUVER Change the air flow by rotating up or down. Direct cool air from left to right by moving center tab.

STARTING AND STOPPING Use normal operating procedures for your car. Because when you start or stop, the air conditioner automatically shuts off.

OPERATION Close all fresh air vents and windows. If your car is parked in the hot sun, turn FAN to high. As you start to drive open a window so the super-heated air which has built up inside your car can vent. After a few minutes, close windows and

vents. Adjust FAN and thermostat to desired positions.

OFF SEASON When your air conditioner has not been in use for a long time, it should be "exercised" every week. Set FAN volume on high and TEMP on maximum cooling for about 5 minutes every week. This keeps the seals lubricated.

MAINTENANCE When you take your car in for servicing, always ask your Authorized Dealer to check your air conditioner. Never let the car be lifted without checking condenser and refrigerant hose clearance. Your Dealer knows how to handle this.

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
